Subject: Follow up on Circular number 88-PS/CIR/2021/60 – Quarantine Release

Dear Sir/Madam,

Reference is made to the Announcement Number 2021/67, and (IUL)452/452/2021/13 published on the Government of Maldives Gazette by the Health Protection Agency (HPA), as well as the circular number 88-PS/CIR/2021/60 dated 7th July 2021 from the Ministry of Tourism.

Pursuant to these announcements and the recent eases granted, individuals who have travelled to local islands / tourist establishments from Male' and are currently undergoing the mandatory home quarantine can now be released from quarantine with a negative PCR test, given that they have completed 14 days since their 2nd dose of vaccination. Additionally, kids or infants who are ineligible for vaccination and are undergoing quarantine, can also be released with a negative PCR result.

In this regard, work permit holders or locals arriving to Maldives from abroad who have already completed 7 days of their mandatory quarantine period can also be released from quarantine, given that they have completed 14 days since their 2nd dose of vaccination of any vaccine approved and listed by the WHO for Covid-19 Emergency Use.
