Subject: **Boundary Regulation – Number: 2023/R-90**

Dear Sir/Madam,

The principle provisions outlined in the Regulation number: 2023/R-90 Boundary Regulation, (the “Regulation”) published on 14th March 2023 are as follows:

- The boundary of tourist establishments **will now be determined from the mean tide line**, as opposed to the former vegetation line.
- The 500-meter boundary **can be extended up to 1000-meters** upon **payment of a fee of USD \$100,000**, subject to the conditions set out in the Regulation

Hence, the Ministry of Tourism would like to request the tourist establishments required under the aforementioned Regulation to promptly complete and submit demarcations of their respective boundaries. As such, please submit the following documents via email (planning@tourism.gov.mv) to the Ministry;

- 02 (two) hard copies of the boundary demarcation report along with a clear & precise map of the demarcated area endorsed by a certified surveyor
- The CAD files of the boundary demarcation

However, if the boundary of your tourist establishment has already been demarcated and approved, or the boundary demarcations are annexed with the lease agreement, please share with us a copy via email.

Additionally, the tourist establishments wishing to extend their current boundaries are invited to submit a “**Letter of Interest**” to the Ministry before 30th June 2023.
