What is eFaas ?

- eFaas is the common password used by individuals to transact with various e-Government services online

Who can register for an eFaas

- Any Maldivian with a valid National ID Card
- Selected Employment Approval (Work Permit) holders

What is my eFaas ID or Username ?

- For Maldivians, their eFaas ID/Username is their National ID Card number and for Employment Approval holders, it is their Employment Approval number


