Subject: **Addition to Circular number 88-PS/CIR/2021/41**

Dear Sir/Madam,

Reference is made to our circular number 88-PS/CIR/2021/41 dated 10<sup>th</sup> May 2021, and the Health Protection Agency (HPA)'s circular number 23-L/CIR/2021/12 dated 12<sup>th</sup> June 2021.

Our circular number 88-PS/CIR/2021/41 had stated the following:

1. "Quarantine Exemption", formally eligible for those who have completed vaccination 14 days prior to, and to those who were positive and recovered within 90 days of travel to the destination, **HAS BEEN TEMPORARILY HALTED** and therefore, travelers falling into these categories would also need to undergo mandatory travel quarantine and testing, till further notice.

However, pursuant to the aforementioned circular by HPA, it is now specified that testing or exit-screening pursuant to the travel quarantine period is not required for such cases (as above) **if asymptomatic** at the end of the 14-day period. If symptomatic, testing is still required, and they are required to remain isolated till a confirmed Negative result is issued.
