Subject: **New Travel Measures for Staff and Worker's Travelling from Abroad to Tourist Resorts and Developing Resorts**

Dear Sir/Madam,

As per the announcement of HPA (Number 1/2021) dated 27th January 2021, regarding the preventive measures taken against Covid-19, the following change has been brought for the staff or worker's **(including work permit holders, business visa holders and corporate resident visa holders and special visa holders)** travelling from abroad to resorts and developing resort:

- Obtain the permit through the mechanism in place at that point of time, prior to travel from the Ministry of Tourism.
- A PCR negative result from a test done within 96 hours of travel from the first port of embarkation en-route to Maldives
- Submit the health declaration form and other required details through Maldives Immigration's 'IMUGA Portal' prior to a time frame of 24 hours before arrival in Maldives.
- Individuals travelling from abroad to resorts and developing islands are **required to undergo the mandatory quarantine of 10 days and obtain a PCR negative result before reporting to work.**
- Quarantine period starting date will be counted as upon arrival date to the resort or developing Island.
- Individuals travelling from abroad with registered work quarantines at tourist establishments cannot extend quarantine start period OR remain in Greater Male' Area for any purpose.
